

Safe Return Transition Care: Care for Your First 24 Hours at Home from the Hospital or Rehab

You have been in the hospital, rehab or a nursing home and now you are going home. Let A Helping Hand Home Care Services make your transition home easy on you and your loved ones and help reduce the likelihood of re-admission.

- Transport and assist you to your home in a private car
- Help you get settled comfortably at home and unpack and put away your belongings
- Pick up prescriptions and other supplies
- Check the refrigerator for spoiled food
- Make the bed with clean linens
- Prepare nutritious meals

Once you are at home, we will stay with you for the first 24 hours (or a time of your choosing) to be sure that you are safe and well taken care of during your transition. Remember that medical or therapy services do not start for a day or two once you are home.

During your transition care, we will:

- Help with showering and/or toileting if needed
- Prepare your meals so that you can regain strength and follow diet if prescribed
- Remind you of your medication and other orders
- Do light housekeeping to freshen up your home
- Do laundry, fold and put clothes away
- Go to the grocery store so that you have what you need on hand
